### **Reproductive Physiology**

Male Reproductive System Testis Sex organ that produces sperm in a process called spermatogenesis and male sex hormones testosterone Developed in a male fetus near the kidneys and descend to the scrotum about 2 months before birth Each testis is enclosed by a layer of fibrous connective tissue called tunica albuginea

### **Puberty and Reproduction**

Show students slide four that has both the male and female interior diagrams on it together Explain to students that only some of the male and female body parts are needed for reproduction and therefore are part of the reproductive system Say “On the male diagram the parts that are used in reproduction are the testicles penis urethra and vas deferens” Say “On the female diagram
